The Board of Governors considered the matter at its earlier meeting held on January 9, 2011 with regard to consideration of request by DME, Chennai and DGHS, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare regarding approval of excess admission made at Stanley Medical College, Chennai during the academic year 2011-12 and also consider the request by reducing one seat from the academic year 2012-13 and the Board had requested Dr. K Mohandas to examine the matter.

On perusing the entire correspondence available between the Govt. of Tamil Nadu (Addl. Director of Medical Education) and the Ministry of H&F.W., Govt. of India (Asst.DGHS (M.E.), it is observed that the situation of excess admission arose out of lack/mis-communication by the Addl.DME(T.N) to the Asst. DGHS-ME(GoI). The Addl. DME(T.N) cites the receipt of wrong communication from the Dean, Stanley Medical College, Chennai as the reason for her mis-communication to the Asst. DGHS (GOI), which resulted in the excess admission. There is also the reluctance/apathy on the part of the authorities to rectify the situation in time. The result of all this is that a candidate admitted under the All India quota in a State Govt. Medical College is being penalized for no fault of hers/his.

The Board taking into consideration the request from the Asst. DGHS-M.E (GoI), regularized the excess admission in M.S.(Ophthalmology) in the Govt. Stanley Medical College and one seat reduced in M.s.(Ophthalmology) from the academic year 2012-13. The BOG also asked the Govt. to fix responsibility and make sure that it is not repeated in future.

10. Renting of Auditorium for information

This is for information of the full Board that Chairman had ordered that the renting be limited only to the government organizations for any official/professional activities. The auditorium shall not be rented to any private person or for any private activity. The time period will be maximum of two days only on non-working days. The charges increased to Rs. 20,000/per day (for maximum of four hours). After deliberation it was decided to charge Rs.10,000/per day for auditorium for MOHFW activity.
