## Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Governors dt. 13.08.2012

Reference Medical Council of India meeting notice dated 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2012, the meeting of the Board of Governors was held on 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2012 at 10.00 a.m. in the Council office at Sector-8, Pocket-14, Dwarka, New Delhi -110077 under the Chairmanship of Dr. (Prof.) K.K. Talwar, Chairperson, Board of Governors. The following members of the Board of Governors attended the meeting:-

Apologies for absence were received from Dr. (Prof.) K.S. Sharma & Dr. Purshottam Lal.

The agenda for the meeting was as under:-

## 1. <u>Minutes of the BOG's meeting dated 07.08.2012 - Confirmation of.</u>

The minutes of the meeting of the Board of Governors held on 07.08.2012 under the Chairmanship of Prof. K.K. Talwar, Chairperson, Board of Governors were confirmed.

#### 2. <u>Clarification regarding Equivalence of National Institute of Open</u> <u>Schooling Certificates.</u>

The Board of Governors considered the agenda note and noted the contents of the letter received from the Director, National Institute of Open

Schooling dated 28.05.2012 and thereafter decided that since the regulations do not specify as to qualification granted by particular Board will be recognized, therefore, if the requirement of Graduate Medical Education Regulations regarding eligibility criteria for admission to MBBS course are fulfilled by the students appearing in 10+2 examination conducted by the National Institute of Open Schooling they may be considered eligible for admission to MBBS course.

## 3. <u>Consideration of re-admission cases in MBBS course at various medical</u> <u>colleges.</u>

The Board of Governors considered the agenda notes and decided that in the matter relating to Ms. Rehla Tariq Rehman, decision which has already been taken on file may be followed. Similarly, the case relating to Mr. Nitin Mainra wherein the gap period is 13 years is not allowed for readmission. So far as other cases are concerned the Board of Governors decided the following:-

That the cases wherein request is received for re-admission may be considered on case to case basis by the Sub-Committee of BOGs, Dr. Purshottam Lal and Dr.(Prof.) K. Mohandas. The following criteria may be considered by the Sub-Committee:-

- (a) The candidate should have passed 1<sup>st</sup> MBBS examination.
- *(b) Ground on which the candidate discontinued the study after passing* 1<sup>*st*</sup> *professional MBBS along with documentary evidence may be obtained.*
- (c) The Sub-Committee should consider case on individual merit and submit recommendation for consideration by the BOGs.

#### 4. <u>Proposed amendment in Establishment of Medical College Regulation,</u> <u>1999 reg. schedule for receipt of applications for Establishment of New</u> <u>Medical Colleges and processing of the applications by the Central</u> <u>Government and the Medical Council of India.</u>

The Board of Governors considered the agenda note and the existing schedule in respect of undergraduate and postgraduate (Broad speciality and super-speciality courses) and decided to approve the insertion of following para after note (2) in Undergraduate Regulations and note No.3 in Postgraduate Regulations:-

"The time schedule indicated above may be modified by the Central Government, for reasons to be recorded in writing, in respect of any class or category of applications".

#### 5. <u>Consideration of the schedule of the meeting of the BOG.</u>

The Board of Governors decided that all BOG members may submit the information/their suggestions regarding the schedule for the meeting of the BOGs which will be compiled and then final decision will be taken.

6. <u>Consideration of cases of migration after the scheduled period</u> prescribed in the Regulations for migration on medical grounds as per provisions of the Graduate Medical Education Regulations. Case of Ms.Neelima Soni alongwith other policy decisions applicable on all such cases applying on medical grounds – Ms.Shweta Vinodhbai Patel,Mr.Dahiphale Vijay Anantrao & Mr.Ayapati Gautam Mehdi.

The Board of Governors considered the agenda note and perused the cases which were put up to the BOGs and noted that the candidates may be asked to submit the following:-

- a. Certificate from State Medical Board in case the transfer/migration has been sought on medical grounds, as the same has not been submitted;
- b. While asking for the medical certificate from the State Medical Board the candidates may also be informed that the candidate has to repeat the study from the beginning of professional year in which the candidate is transferred/migrated to other medical college;
- c. Once the information complete in all respect is received from the candidates who are seeking migration the same may be put up by Medical Misc. Section to the Sub-Committee of the members of BOGs, Dr. Purshottam Lal and Dr.(Prof.) K. Mohandas.

## 7. <u>Medical Council of India inputs on PIL No. 3486/2012 – Court on own</u> <u>mention vs Union of India and Ors in the Hon'ble High Court of</u> <u>Jharkhand.</u>

The Board of Governors went through the agenda note and approved the contents of letter to be sent to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & F.W. for onward submission to the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand.

8. <u>Consideration of matter relating to - increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry under Vinayaka Mission University, Salem u/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956, in compliance to the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. No.3772/2012.</u>

The Board of Governors considered the agenda note and passed the detailed order which is placed on the concerned subject file of Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry.

9. <u>Consideration of matter relating to - increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry under Vinayaka Mission University, Salem u/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956, in compliance to the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. No.3772/2012.</u>

The Board of Governors considered the agenda note and passed the detailed order which is placed on the concerned subject file of Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry.

10. <u>Consideration of matter relating to increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics)</u> <u>& DCH course at MVJ Medical College, & Research Hospital, Bangalore</u> <u>under Rajiv Gandhi University of health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of</u> <u>the IMC Act, 1956 - in compliance of the direction of the Hon'ble High</u> <u>Court of Karnataka at Bangalore dt. 30.05.2012</u>

The Board of Governors considered the agenda note, the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka dated 30.05.2012 and the note put up by the PG Section based on the assessment report of MVJ Medical College & Research Hospital, Bangalore.
