#### 1. <u>Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – confirmation of.</u>

The Postgraduate Committee confirmed the minutes of the Postgraduate Committee meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 with the following modifications:

The minutes under item no. 8, 11 and 82 be read corrected as under:

#### 8(CR).<u>Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada - Recognition of MD(Psychiatry) qualification in respect of students being trained at N.R.I. Medical College and Hospital, Guntur.</u>

Read: the compliance alongwith the assessment report (May, 2012) & (June, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at N.R.I. Medical College and Hospital, Guntur for Recognition of

MD(Psychiatry) qualification granted by the Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance along with the Council assessor's report (May, 2012) & (June, 2013) and decided to recommend that MD(Psychiatry) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, Balagangadharanath Nagar be recognized for 1(One) seat and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

#### 11(CR). <u>Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P. -</u> <u>Recognition of MD(Radio Diagnosis) qualification at Katuri Medical College.</u>

Read: the information supplied by U.G. Section alongwith the assessment report (May, 2012) & (June, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Katuri Medical College, Guntur for Recognition of MD(Radiology/Radio Diagnosis)qualification granted by the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (May, 2012) & (June, 2013) along with the information supplied by U.G. Section and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Radio-Diagnosis) qualification for 3(Three) seats granted by Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada in respect of students being trained at Katuri Medical College, Guntur because of the followings:-

- 1. No DSA
- 2. Static X-ray 4 against the requirement of 6.
- 3. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

#### 82. <u>Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow -</u> <u>Recognition of MS(ENT) qualifications in respect of students being trained at Command Hospital, Lucknow.</u>

Read: the assessment report (12.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(ENT) qualifications at Command Hospital, Lucknow granted by Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (29.04.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MS(ENT) qualification granted by Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow in respect of students being trained at Command Hospital, Lucknow because of the followings:-

- 1. The Command Hospital, Lucknow does not appear in the list of teaching hospitals provided by DGAFMS vide letter No. 8510/PG Teachers/DGAFM/ODG-ID dated 02/08/2002 and approved by MCI.
- 2. The period for which the faculty members have worked as Graded, Classified Specialists, Advisor/ Consultant in the subject (Speciality/ Super Speciality) by which their equivalent teaching rank (Asst. Professor,

- Assoc. Professor or Professor) has to be calculated have not been provided.
- 3. Hospital does not fulfill the requirements laid down in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 (Amendment, 2005) dated 16/03/2005.
- 4. HoD is Assoc. Professor, which is not acceptable.
- 5. Equipment like BERA is not available.
- 6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

#### 2. <u>Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – action taken</u> thereon.

The Postgraduate Committee noted & approved the action taken on the minutes of the meeting of the Postgraduate Committee held on 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2014.

At the outset, the Postgraduate Committee passed the following resolution:

"It has been observed that many institutions employ MBBS degree holders as Senior Resident and claim that they have three years experience as Junior Resident without specifying the subject/department in which they have worked as Junior Resident. In all such cases, a certificate of experience signed by concerned HOD and Dean and appointment letter alongwith proof of salary paid to them (Bank Transfer, Form 16) for the full period of JR ship be obtained. Unless all these documents are produced the person concerned should not be accepted as Senior Resident. This decision should be incorporated in the letter being sent to the Assessors."

The above Resolution taken by the Postgraduate Committee was read out and confirmed in the meeting itself.

3. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh - Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 04 to 08 and renewal of recognition of DCH qualification for 2 seats in respect of students being trained at Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru.

Read: the assessment report (17.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 04 to 08 and renewal of recognition of DCH qualification for 2 seats at Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (17.05.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 04 to 08 seats granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh in respect of students being trained at Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Committee further decided to recommend continuation of the recognition of DCH qualification for 2(Two) seats granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh in respect of students being trained at Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

#### 4. Vinayaka Mission's University, Salem - Renewal of recognition of DGO qualification in respect of students being trained at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry.

Read: the assessment report (29.04.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of recognition of DGO qualification at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry granted by Vinayaka Mission's University, Salem.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (29.04.2014) and decided to recommend not to renew the recognition of DGO qualification granted by Vinayaka Mission's University, Salem in respect of students being trained at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry because of the following:-

- 1. Daily Major operations 4 and Minor 8.
- 2. Daily deliveries conducted 2
- 3. Daily caesarian section -1
- 4. Both daily deliveries and caesarian sections are static for the last 3 years.
- 5. There is no semen bank.
- 6. Daily MRI in the institute is only 4.
- 7. All these above reflect low clinical material.
- 8. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

# 5. Vinayaka Mission's University, Salem - Renewal of recognition of DCH qualification for 02 seats and recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats in respect of students being trained at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry.

Read: the assessment report (12.04.2014 & 28.04.2014 in respectively) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of recognition of DCH qualification for 02 seats and recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry granted by Vinayaka Mission's University, Salem.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (12.04.2014 & 28.04.2014 in respectively) and decided to recommend not to renew the recognition of DCH qualification for 02 seats and not to recognize MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats granted by Vinayaka Mission's University, Salem in respect of students being trained at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry because of the following:-

- 1. There is no Asso. Prof. in Unit I; resultantly faculty complement is incomplete.
- 2. Variety of cases required for PG training is not available. Most of the admitted cases were viral fever & cough not requiring admission.
- 3. Bed occupancy was 70 % on day of assessment.
- 4. Daily investigative workload from the department is less.
- 5. Cases requiring NICU & PICU care were very few (1-2).
- 6. Log books are incomplete. Number of procedures done by students are inadequate.
- 7. There was no variety of cases kept in the examination.
- 8. Total number of patients in OPD has decreased from 42,318 in 2011 to 36,701 in 2013.
- 9. Total number of patients in IPD has decreased from 19,386 in 2011 to 17,948 in 2013.

- 10. 1 Assoc. Professor & 1 Asst. Professor who were available during D.C.H. Assessment were not available during MD assessment, only 12 days apart. This shows temperorary faculty.
- 11. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.
- 6. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore Recognition of MS(OBG) qualification against increased intake from 5 to 6 seats in respect of students being trained at Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, Balagangadharanath Nagar.

Read: the assessment report (27.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(OBG) qualification against increased intake from 5 to 6 seats at Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, Balagangadharanath Nagar granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (27.05.2014) and decided to recommend that MS(OBG) qualification against increased intake from 05 to 06 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, Balagangadharanath Nagar be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. - 1. In Vertigo clinic, ENG Machine was not working and there was no operator to operate the machine.
- 2. Temporal bone dissection laboratory & examination chamber of Asso. Prof. are in one room.
- 3. Tracheostomy Tray set was not available in ENT male & female ward.
- 4. Doctors' duty room is not available in male & female wards.
- 5. Dr. Niveditha, Senior Resident has not shown original M.B;B.S. degree.
- 6. Average daily operative workload of major surgeries is 2-3 which is inadequate.
- 7. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.
- 9. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore Recognition of MD(DVL) qualification against increased intake from 1 to 2 seats in respect of students being trained at Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, Balagangadharanath Nagar.

Read: the assessment report (27.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(DVL) qualification against increased intake from 1 to 2 seats at Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, Balagangadharanath Nagar granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

- 1. Unit II is headed by Asst. Prof. & has only 2 faculty; resultantly, it cannot be considered as a teaching Unit at all. Hence there is only 1 functional Unit while the intake is 5 degree & 2 diploma.
- 2. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

#### 14. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Recognition of MD(Microbiology) qualifiation in respect of students being trained at Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences, Belgaum.

Read: the assessment report (29.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Microbiology) qualifiation at Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences, Belgaum granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (29.05.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Microbiology) qualification for 1 (One) seat granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences, Belgaum be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

#### 15. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Recognition of MD(Pathology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences, Belgaum.

Read: the assessment report (30.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Pathology) qualification at Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences, Belgaum granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (30.05.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Pathology) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences, Belgaum because of the following:-

- 1. There is no Pentahead microscope. Equipment is inadequate.
- 2. Deficiency of faculty for PG: (a) Asso. Prof.: 1; (b) Asst. Prof.: 1.
- 3. Average daily Histopathological workload is 4.88 which is inadequate.
- 4. Annual specimens processed for Pathology has decreased from 2,161 in 2011 to 1,784 in 2013.
- 5. Annual specimens processed for Cytology has decreased from 1,484 in 2011 to 1,037 in 2013.
- 6. Frozen section is not available. Immunohistochemistry is not available.
- 7. L.E. cell examination is not performed.
- 8. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

#### 16. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Recognition of MD(Pharmacology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Bidar Institute of Medical Sciences, Bidar.

Shah Medical College & Hospital, Surendra Nagar be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. - 6. Average OPD attendance is 85.
- 7. Although bed occupancy is 80 % but 90 % of them are occupied by patients of low backache, O.A. knee, L.S. Cervical Spondylitis which can be treated on OPD basis.
- 8. Operative load is very less & only 8-10 postoperative patients are present in the ward. There was no surgery on day of assessment.
- 9. There is no office for any faculty except for Professor.
- 10. In plaster room, no sign of any plaster of Paris was present.

- 11. There is no seminar room or demonstration room. There are no proper training facilities.
- 12. The conduct of examiners was very fishy & whispering manner. The candidate did not know about hip examination, club foot examination, Anatomy or Surgery. One of the examiners was absent in the examination hall at 3 p.m.

- 14. There are no publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years.
- 15. Arthroscopy & Joint replacement facilities are not available.

- 10. Delivery data at Sr. No. 14 and Sr. No. 2 of part-2 does not match.
- 11. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

- 5. There are no seminar rooms in the department.
- 6. There is no L.M.O. at RHTC.
- 7. Interns are not staying at RHTC. There is no cook available. There are no indoor patients in RHTC.
- 8. Department is having computer but there is no Wi-Fi or internet.
- 9. There is no designated post of Epidemiologist.
- 10. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

#### 74. <u>Sri Siddhartha University, Tumkur - Recognition of MS(ENT) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats in respect of students being trained at Sri Siddhartha Medical College, Tumkur.</u>

- 4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

- 4. There is no MR Scan and Mamography in the institution.
- 5. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

- 1. There is no separate room for Phototherapy unit & is kept in consultation room which is hazardous to doctors & patients.
- 2. Only 2 rooms are available for faculty which is inadequate.
- 3. On random checking and comparing departmental register & central records, average OPD was only 30 35 patients / day.
- 4. Most of the patients admitted in ward on the day of assessment were admitted were admitted on two particular days. Out of 30 beds occupied, only 20 qualified for hospitalization.

- 3. No new books have been purchased in last 3 years in departmental library. All the journals have been donated by faculty.
- 4. There is no separate Burns ward.
- 5. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

#### 82. The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai - Recognition of MD(Physiology) qualification increased intake from 2 to 4 seats in respect of students being trained at Christian Medical College, Vellore.

Read: the assessment report (21.04.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Physiology) qualification increased intake from 2 to 4 seats at Christian Medical College, Vellore granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the assessment report (21.04.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Physiology) qualification increased intake from 2 to 4 seats granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai in respect of students being trained at Christian Medical College, Vellore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. - 3. Speciality clinics like Gynaec Endocrine clinic, Menopause clinic are not available.
- 4. Unit III has only 2 faculty; hence it cannot be considered as PG Unit; resultantly there are only 2 functional PG Units.
- 5. Daily OPD 80-85, per day
- 6. Daily operations Major: 3 and Minor: 1, which is inadequate.
- 7. 3 years data not provided.
- 8. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

#### 84. <u>Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik - Recognition of MS(OBG)</u> qualification in respect of students being trained at Dr. Panjabrao Alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati.

Read: the assessment report (28.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(OBG) qualification at Dr. Panjabrao Alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (28.05.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MS(OBG) qualification granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Dr. Panjabrao Alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati because of the followings:-

- 1. There is no separate Obstetric ICU. It is shared with SICU.
- 2. Normal deliveries have decreased from 1,116 in 2011 to 946 in 2,013. Instrumental deliveries have decreased from 45 to 28 during the same period.
- 3. There are no abortions although total number of deliveries are claimed to be 1,564 which is not feasible.

- 4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

- 5. There is no separate O.T. for the department. There is general O.T. where only 2 days / week are allotted for Gynaecology operations.
- 6. Promotion of Dr. Nalini Arora, Professor as Asso. Prof. is not as per Regulations as she has been promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 4 y 2 m as Asst. Prof. against requirement of 5 y as per Regulations.
- 7. There is no computer in the department office.
- 8. There is no separate Obstetric ICU.
- 9. IVF services are through tie up with private IVF center.
- 10. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

The gas system is not under the control of the department & is privatized. It is a very serious issue if any mishap takes place, nobody is answerable as there is no proper communication system.
- 4. Emergency operations are only 1 / day.
- 5. Paramedical staffs are 10th/12th standard pass but not in science subjects and are not having any diplomas or certificates of training.
- 6. Obstetric O.T. does not have neonatal monitoring system.
- 7. Playground is not in a condition to play any games.
- 8. Library: It is not air conditioned. Librarian is irregular since October 2013. The staff could not produce main textbook of Anaesthesia.
- 9. During the examination, the mannequin for demonstration of CPR was not placed.
- 10. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

- 3. Accident & emergency department does not have any regular CMO posted for round the clock duty.
- 4. Medical OPD has an injection room under the stairs which has only a patient couch without a fan. There is no drug / resuscitation etc. available in case of reaction.
- 5. Office space for Asst. Prof. is not adequate. There is only 1 room available for all the 17 Asst. Prof. & this room has only 10 office desks put across against each.
- 6. There was no pay scale of teachers on appointment letters. Some of Asst. Prof. are getting consolidated pay of Rs. 32,500.00. However other Asst. Prof. are getting different consolidated pay ranging from Rs. 40,000 to 2,20,000 per month. Majority of Professors are getting fixed pay of Rs.

- 60,000 to 70,000 per month. Form 16 for the year ending on 31/03/2014 was not submitted for any faculty.
- 7. No separate room for storage of dirty & clean linen or drugs is available.
- 8. Total number of patients in OPD has decreased from 1,52,570 in 2012 to 1,46,547 in 2013. Total number of patients in IPD has decreased from 11,078 to 8,406 during the same period.
- 9. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

Read: the assessment report (09.04.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Community Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 03 to 04 seats at Mahatama Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute, Pondicherry granted by Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth University, Puducherry.

205(CR). <u>Utkal University, Orissa – Recognition of M.Ch.(Neuro Surgery)</u> <u>qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats in respect of students being trained at SCB Medical College, Cuttack.</u>

Read: the compliance verification assessment report (June, 2014) and compliance along with assessment report (July, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of M.Ch. (Neuro Surgery) qualification against

increased intake from 02 to 03 seats at SCB Medical College, Cuttack granted by Utkal University, Orissa.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Compliance verification assessment report (June, 2014) and compliance along with assessment report (July, 2013) and decided to recommend that M.Ch. (Neuro-Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats granted by Utkal University in respect of students being trained at SCB Medical College, Cuttack be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

206(CR). <u>Allahabad University & Chhatarpati Sahuji Maharaj Medical</u>
<u>University, Lucknow – Recognition of D.Ortho. qualification in respect</u>
of students being trained at M.L.N. Medical College, Allahabad.

Read: the compliance verification assessment report (August, 2014) and compliance along with assessment report (May, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of D.Ortho. qualification at M.L.N. Medical College, Allahabad granted by Allahabad University & Chhatarpati Sahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification assessment report (August, 2014) and compliance along with assessment report (May, 2009) and decided to recommend not to recognize D.Ortho. qualification granted by Allahabad University & Chhatarpati Sahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow in respect of students being trained at M.L.N. Medical College, Allahabad because of the followings:

- 1. After the decision of the PG Committee was communicated to the college authorities and they were directed to stop admission to D.Ortho course from 2009-10, neither the college Principal nor affiliating university has sent any compliance. Compliance has been sent by Dr. D.C. Srivastava of Orthopaedic Department on 25/05/2012 and it is not signed by Principal anywhere. As per regulations, the compliance should come from affiliating university whose degree is to be recognized and college Principal.
- 2. As per regulations, department of Orthopaedics should have 2 units. However, the department has faculty for one Unit only as below:

(i) **Professor:** Dr. D.C. Srivastava (His promotion is not as

per regulations since he has been Assoc. Professor for 3 years 1 month against the requirement of 4 years. Hence, he cannot be considered Professor. No proof of publications

given.)

(ii) Assoc. Professor: Dr. K. Dwivedi(iii) Lecturer: Dr. Vikas Nigam

(iv) Lecturer

(In place of Sr. Resident): Dr. Mukul Singh (Joined 3 months back)

(v) Junior Resident: Nil

#### UNIT-II

(i) Professor: Nil(ii) Assoc. Professor: Nil

(iii) Lecturer: Dr. Ahmar Hasmat (Joined 3 months back)(iv) Lecturer: Dr. A.K. Verma – Not eligible since he has no

teaching experience of 3 years in Orthopaedics in a teaching Hospital or medical collegeat the time of appointment. (Dr. A.K. Verma be asked to appear before the Postgraduate Committee on 23/09/2014 for submitting his clarification as regards his eligibility to the post of Lecturer

in the medical college as per MCI regulation)

(v) Sr. Resident: Nil (vi) Jr. Resident: Nil

Hence, there is deficiency of on complete Unit.

The Department is admitting 5 PG students (3 MS and 2 D.Ortho.) although there are only two faculty member eligible to be considered as P.G. teacher. However, they are directed to stop further admissions.

- 3. Only 26 Books purchased in Central library since the last 3 years. Out of these 22 cannot be orthopaedic books as has been stated (Departmental library 22 books)
- 4. Casualty Beds stated 200 in SAF, which is not feasible and practical.
- 5. As per page 7 of SAF, there is no CT Scan, No MRI. Total ultrasound done per day in entire hospital is only 26, which is very less. Availability of these investigations is essential.
- 6. Total Beds stated in SAF (ICCU- 40; ICU- 86) neither feasible nor practical.
- 7. The entire essential background information about the institution and department (as per columns in SAF) has either not been provided or not signed by Dean/ Principal/ Medical Suptd. who are authorized signatories.
- 8. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

### 207(CR). Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Recognition of MS(General Surgery) qualification in respect of students being trained at K V G Medical College, Kurunjibag, Sullia.

Read: the compliance verification assessment report (August, 2014) in pursuance to the Court Order and compliance along with assessment report (May, 2012) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(General Surgery) qualification at K V G Medical College, Kurunjibag, Sullia granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification assessment report (August, 2014) in pursuance to the Court Order and compliance along with assessment report (May, 2012) and decided to recommend not to recognize MS(General Surgery) qualification at K V G Medical College, Kurunjibag, Sullia granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore because of the followings:

- 1. Accident and emergency attendance of Surgery patients only 6-7 per day, which is less.
- 2. Total MRI in the institution 4-5 per day and in Surgery department 0-1 per day, which is not only less but indicates that seiours patients are not admitted.

- 3. Out of 10 Asst. Professors, 2 were absent at the time of inspection and 6 joined 7 days, 17 days, 1 month, 1 month, 3 months and 4 months back respectively, which means they had been called for assessment purpose.
- 4. Out of 7 Senior Residents, 5 joined 1 month, 1 month, 1 month, 1 month and 5 months back respectively, which means they had been called for assessment purpose.
- 5. Since last inspection in June, 2013, 60% faculty had left. Only 7 teachers who were present in June, 2013 are present in August, 2014. This indicates that stable faculty is much less.
- 6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

### 208. Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the assessment report (08/08/2014) in pursuance to the order dated 03/07/2014 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16.

In pursuance to the order dated 03/07/2014 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India the Postgraduate Committee considered the assessment report (08/08/2014) for Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 and the committee noted that there is no experience certificate of Senior Residents attached. It was decided to obtain experience certificate (which are not attached) and proof of salary paid during JR ships of Nine Senior Residents who are only MBBS and four Senior Residents who are DA. The experience certificate should be of the period of Junior residency and signed by the then HoD of concerned department and Dean. The salary proof should be bank transfer and Form-16 for the entire period of Junior residency.

## 209. Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the assessment report (11/08/2014) in pursuance to the order dated 03/07/2014 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16.

In pursuance to the order dated 03/07/2014 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India the Postgraduate Committee considered the assessment report (11/08/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 because of the following reasons:

- 1. There is no Senior Residents in Unit-II, VI & VII. 5 Senior Residents Dr. Meghna Nemani passed M.D. in April, 2014. She has been shown as Senior Resident from 16/11/2010 till date at once place. At the same time she has been shown as Senior Resident from 02/06/2014 till date and Resident from 30/05/2011 to 01/06/2014, which is not possible.
- 2. There are total of 3 Senior Residents against the requirement of 12 (requirement as per 200 UG seats)

- 3. Promotion of Dr. Manne Sri Hari Babu, Professor Unit-III is not as per regulations. He has been Assoc. Professor only for 3 years-2 months agains the requirement of 4 years.
- 4. Average daily MRI during last 3 years only 1-2, which is very less and indicate poor clinical material.
- 5. In intensive Care Areas (ANC, ICCU, Dialysis and RICU) the equipment has only been named, exact numbers not given.
- 6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

### 210. <u>Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry</u> (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the assessment report (11/08/2014) in pursuance to the order dated 03/07/2014 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16.

In pursuance to the order dated 03/07/2014 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (11/08/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 because of the following reasons:-

- 1. At 11 AM attendance, only six faculty members were present after personally visiting and meeting them all at all their places of work and taking their signatures. (Professors-2, Associate Professor-2 and Assistant Professors-2). If this faculty position is taken into consideration, requirement of four PG Units composition is incomplete with only two units being complete. However, at the time of declaration form verification at 2 PM, the department strength was (Professor-5, Assoc. Professor-4 and Asst. Professor-6).
- 2. Name of Dr. B. Swarajya Lakshmi (66 Years old), said to be full time Professor does not appear in any of the OBG operation theatre registers for several preceding months. She reported in hospital at 3 pm. She gets only Rs. 60,000/- PM salary which is not commensurate with her age, seniority and experience. She has not been accepted since she does not appear to be full time.
- 3. There is marked variability in salary structure of same category of faculty members and Senior Residents with comparable work experience.
- 4. Dr. Thalluri Percy Evangele, said to be Senior Resident has not been accepted being 61 years of age.
- 5. Dr. Vemula Sravanthi, said to be Senior Resident has not been accepted as both the proofs of residences attached show her address at Bodhan (Distt. Nizamabad) which is 500 km away and salary of only Rs. 20,000 pm.
- 6. There is net deficiency of one Senior Resident in the deptt.
- 7. On the day of assessment, bed occupancy of genuine patients requiring admission (after physically examining them) was 50-55% only. Rest patients were admitted for minor ailments like vaginal discharge, mild anaemia, paid abdomen and backache. Many routine caesarean section patients were still not being discharged even after 9 or 10 days of surgery, though they all were found fit for discharge.

- 8. Except Dr. Y. Himabindu, none of the faculty members including HoD has any publications.
- 9. Experience certificate from concerned HoD and Dean for the period of JR ship and Proof of salary paid during the entire period of JR ship (Bank transfer/Form-16) for the following Senior Residents is not provided:
  - a. Dr. Thalluri Percy Evangelene, Sr. Resident, Unit-I
  - b. Dr. Vemula Sravanthi, Sr. Resident, Unit-I
  - c. Dr. Kasturi Aravapalli, Sr. Resident, Unit-II
  - d. Dr. K. Swathi, Sr. Resident, Unit-IV Hence, they cannot be considered as Senior Residents.
- 10. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

### 211. Increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the assessment report (11/08/2014) in pursuance to the order dated 03/07/2014 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for Increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16.

In pursuance to the order dated 03/07/2014 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (11/08/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) course at GSL Medical College, Rajahmundry (A.P.) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 because of the following reasons:-

- 1. On the day of assessment:
  - i. Only 4 patients in Casualty.
  - ii. No surgeries done in emergency.
  - iii. Only one major case and three minor cases were listed for elective OT.
  - iv. Around 30 patients were in OPD till noon.
  - v. 11 plain X-rays of out petients taken till noon.
  - vi. SICU had 6 out of 13 beds occupied.
  - vii. Post operative ward had no patient.
- 2. All registers have been contrived to inflate figures.
- 3. Among the publications from department: serial No. 1 and 8 are the same work published in different journals. So is the case of serial no. 7 and 9.
- 4. Occupational therapy and artificial limb centre/ orthotic facility are not available.
- 5. Total Daily operative load:
  - i. Major Surgeries: 2 3
  - ii. Minor Surgeries: 4 6

This is very less for a college of 200 UG seats.

- 6. Only one CT Scan done on inspection day.
- 7. No MRI done on inspection day.
- 8. Three years data of OPD, IPD, Major & Minor surgeries, and Histopathologies not provided.

- 9. Experience certificate from concerned HoD & Dean of JR ship of following Senior Residents is not provided. Hence, they cannot be considered as Senior Residents:
  - i. Dr. Ramesh Reddy
  - ii. Dr. Srinivas Bodapati
  - iii. Dr. Kanagara Nageshwar Rao
  - iv. Dr. KVT Saikumar
  - v. Dr. M. Suresh Kumar
  - vi. Dr. Dontamsetti Buddudu
- 10. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.
