1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – confirmation of.

The Postgraduate Committee confirmed the minutes of the Postgraduate Committee meeting held on 10th June, 2014.

2. <u>Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – action taken</u> <u>thereon.</u>

The Postgraduate Committee noted & approved the action taken on the minutes of the meeting of the Postgraduate Committee held on 10th June, 2014.

3. <u>Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University - Recognition of MD/MS(Anatomy)</u> <u>qualification at Amrita School of Medicine, AIMS, Kochi.</u>

Read: the assessment report (16.04.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD/MS(Anatomy) qualification at Amrita School of Medicine, AIMS, Kochi granted by Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the assessment report (16.04.2014) and decided to recommend that MD/MS(Anatomy) qualification for 2(Two) seats granted by Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University in respect of students being trained at Amrita School of Medicine, AIMS, Kochi be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

4. <u>Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University - Recognition of MD(Psychiatry)</u> gualification at Amrita School of Medicine, AIMS, Kochi.

Read: the assessment report (26.04.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Psychiatry) qualification at Amrita School of Medicine, AIMS, Kochi granted by Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the assessment report (26.04.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Psychiatry) qualification for 2(Two) seats granted by Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University in respect of students being trained at Amrita School of Medicine, AIMS, Kochi be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

5. <u>The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai - Recognition of</u> <u>MD/MS(Ophthalmology) qualification against increased intake from 06 (Six)</u> to 12 (Twelve) seats at Aravind Eye Hospitals, Madurai.

Read: the assessment report (15-16.04.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD/MS(Ophthalmology) qualification against increased intake from 06 (Six) to 12 (Twelve) seats at Aravind Eye Hospitals, Madurai granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (15-16.04.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD/MS(Ophthalmology) qualification against increased intake from 06 (Six) to 12 (Twelve) seats granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai in respect of students being trained at Aravind Eye Hospitals, Madurai because of the followings:-

- (i) HOD is also the Director of the institute, which is not acceptable.
- (ii) There are 329 beds in 7 Units; each Unit is having 47 beds, which is not as per regulations.
- (iii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

6. <u>Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow - Recognition of</u> <u>MD(Anaesthesia) qualifications at Command Hospital, Lucknow.</u>

Read: the assessment report (12.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Anaesthesia) qualifications at Command Hospital, Lucknow granted by Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (12.05.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Anaesthesia) qualifications granted by Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow in respect of students being trained at Command Hospital, Lucknow because of the followings:-

- Dr. K. Prabhakaran, Professor is promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 3 y 9 m as Asst. Prof. Against the requirement of 5 y as per Regulations.
- (ii) Dr. R. Setlur, Professor has been promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 4 y 2 m as Asst. Prof. in 2004 against requirement of 5 y as per Regulations & as Professor with experience of only 3 y 8 m in 2008 against requirement of 4 y as per Regulations.
- (iii) Paramedical non-teaching staff is not available in the department.
- (iv) The Command Hospital, Chandimandir does not appear in the list of teaching hospitals provided by DGAFMS vide letter No. 8510/PG Teachers/ DGAFM/ODG-ID dated 02/08/2002 and approved by MCI.
- (v) The period for which the faculty members have worked as Graded, Classified Specialists, Advisor/ Consultant in the subject (Speciality/ Super Speciality) by which their equivalent teaching rank (Asst. Professor, Assoc. Professor or Professor) has to be calculated have not been provided.
- (vi) Hospital does not fulfill the requirements laid down in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 (Amendment, 2005) dated 16/03/2005
- (vii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

The Command Hospital authorities are directed to stop admissions since, the basic requirements laid down in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 are not fulfilled.

7. <u>Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow - Recognition of</u> <u>MS(General Surgery) qualifications at Command Hospital, Lucknow.</u>

Read: the assessment report (10.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(General Surgery) qualifications at Command Hospital, Lucknow granted by Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (10.05.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MS(General Surgery) qualifications granted by Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow in

respect of students being trained at Command Hospital, Lucknow because of the followings:-

- (i) The Command Hospital, Chandimandir does not appear in the list of teaching hospitals provided by DGAFMS vide letter No. 8510/PG Teachers/ DGAFM/ODG-ID dated 02/08/2002 and approved by MCI.
- (ii) The period for which the faculty members have worked as Graded, Classified Specialists, Advisor/ Consultant in the subject (Speciality/ Super Speciality) by which their equivalent teaching rank (Asst. Professor, Assoc. Professor or Professor) has to be calculated have not been provided.
- (iii) Hospital does not fulfill the requirements laid down in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 (Amendment, 2005) dated 16/03/2005
- (iv) There are 130 beds in 2 Units which is not as per Regulations.
- (v) Promotion of Dr. S. Basu, Professor in Unit I is not as per Regulations as he has been promoted as Asso. Prof. With experience of only 3 y 7 m as Asst. Prof. Against requirement of 5 y as per Regulations.
- (vi) Unit III has only 2 faculty; hence it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
- (vii) The HoD is also the Dean, which is not permissible.
- (viii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

The Command Hospital authorities are directed to stop admissions since, the basic requirements laid down in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 are not fulfilled.

8. D.Y. Patil Education Society Deemed University, Kolhapur - Recognition of MS(General Surgery qualification against increased intake from 4 (Four) to 5 (Five) seats at Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Kolhapur.

Read: the assessment report (07.05.2011) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(General Surgery qualification against increased intake from 4 (Four) to 5 (Five) seats at Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Kolhapur granted by D.Y. Patil Education Society Deemed University, Kolhapur.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (07.05.2011) and decided to recommend not to recognize MS (General Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 4 (Four) to 5 (Five) seats granted by D.Y. Patil Education Society Deemed University, Kolhapur in respect of students being trained at Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Kolhapur because of the followings:-

- (i) There is no rotation of Surgery residents in casualty departments.
- (ii) All Senior Residents are MBBS without 3 years experience in Surgery. Hence, they are not eligible to hold the post of Senior Residents. Consequently, there is a deficiency of 9 Senior Residents.
- (iii) Auditorium has the capacity of 350 against the requirement of 750.
- (iv) Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

9. <u>HIHT University, Dehradun - Recognition of MD(Biochemistry) qualification</u> against increased intake from 1 (One) to 3 (Three) seats at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun.

Read: the assessment report (08.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Biochemistry) qualification against increased intake from 1 (One) to 3 (Three) seats at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun granted by HIHT University, Dehradun.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the assessment report (08.05.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Biochemistry) qualification against increased intake from 1 (One) to 3 (Three) seats granted by HIHT University, Dehradun in respect of students being trained at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

10. <u>Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik - Recognition of</u> <u>MD(Forensic Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 02 (Two)</u> to 03 (Three) seats at Indira Gandhi Medical College & Hospital, Nagpur.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (27.05.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Forensic Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 02 (Two) to 03 (Three) seats granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Indira Gandhi Medical College & Hospital, Nagpur because of the followings:-

- (i) There is no Assoc. Professor in the department. Consequently, there is a deficiency of 1 Assoc. Professor.
- (ii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

11. <u>NITTE University, Bangalore - Recognition of MD(Psychiatry) qualification at</u> <u>K S Hegde Medical Academy, Mangalore.</u>

Read: the assessment report (02.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Psychiatry) qualification at K S Hegde Medical Academy, Mangalore granted by NITTE University, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the assessment report (02.05.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Psychiatry) qualification for 1 (One) seat granted by NITTE University, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at K S Hegde Medical Academy, Mangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

12. <u>NITTE University, Bangalore - Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification</u> <u>against increased intake from 2 (Two) to 4 (Four) seats at K S Hegde Medical</u> <u>Academy, Mangalore.</u>

Read: the assessment report (02.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification against increased intake from 2 (Two) to 4 (Four) seats at K S Hegde Medical Academy, Mangalore granted by NITTE University, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (02.05.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MS(Orthopaedics) qualification against increased intake from 2 (Two) to 4 (Four) seats granted by NITTE University, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at K S Hegde Medical Academy, Mangalore because of the followings:-

- (i) There are 2 Units 85 beds against the requirement of 3 Units and 90 beds for a college admitting 150 MBBS students. Consequently, there is a deficiency of 1 Unit and 5 beds.
- (ii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

13. <u>Manipal University, Manipal - Recognition of MD(Pulmonary Medicine)</u> <u>qualfication at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal.</u>

Read: the assessment report (06.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Pulmonary Medicine) qualification at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal granted by Manipal University, Manipal.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (06.05.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Pulmonary Medicine) qualfication granted by Manipal University, Manipal in respect of students being trained at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal because of the followings:-

- (i) Average daily OPD is only 29, which is inadequate.
- (ii) Bed occupancy only 32%.
- (iii) Promotion of Dr. Acharya Preetham Rajgopal is not as per Regulations. He has been promoted Assoc. Professor after 4 years without any publication.
- (iv) Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

14. <u>Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University (Deemed), Karad -</u> <u>Recognition of MD(Pharmacology) qualification in respect of increased intake</u> <u>from 03 (Three) to 04 (Four) seats at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences,</u> <u>Karad.</u>

Read: the assessment report (09-10.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Pharmacology) qualification in respect of increased intake from 03 (Three) to 04 (Four) seats at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad granted by Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University (Deemed), Karad.

Act, 1956.

Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the assessment report (28.05.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Psychiatry) qualification against increased intake from 01 (One) to 02 (Two) seats granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at N.K.P. Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (21.05.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MS(ENT) qualification granted by Arya Bhatta Knowledge University, Patna in respect of students being trained at Nalanda Medical College, Patna because of the followings:-

- (i) Average daily major operations are only 2.63.
- (ii) Promotion of Dr. Sanjay Kumar, Assoc. Professor is irregular. He has been Asst. Professor for 4 years 7 months without 2 publications in indexed journals. Consequently, there is a deficiency of 1 Assoc. Professor.
- (iii) 2 Asst. Professors Dr. Birender Kumar and Dr. Satyendra Sharma joined as Asst. Professor on the day of assessment.
- (iv) Average major surgeries 1.3 per day only.
- (v) Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

20. <u>West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata - Recognition of</u> <u>MD(Radio Diagnosis) qualification at Nilratan Sircar Medical College,</u> <u>Kolkata.</u>

Nilratan Sircar Medical College, Kolkata granted by West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (24.04.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Radio Diagnosis) qualification granted by West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata in respect of students being trained at Nilratan Sircar Medical College, Kolkata because of the followings:-

- (i) Deficiency of faculty for PG: (a) Asso. Prof.: 1.
- (ii) Shortage of Senior Residents: 4.
- (iii) Equipment is very old (16 Slice CT and 1.5 Texla MRI)
- (iv) There are no 800 mA X-ray Machines.
- (v) AERB license not available.
- (vi) Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

21. <u>West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata - Recognition of</u> <u>MD(Pathology) qualification against increased intake from 04 (Four) to 07</u> (Seven) seats at North Bengal Medical College, Darjeeling.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (06.05.2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Pathology) qualification against increased intake from 04 (Four) to 07 (Seven) seats granted by West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata in respect of students being trained at North Bengal Medical College, Darjeeling because of the followings:-
