1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – confirmation of.

No objection/observation made by any member of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee. The minutes of the last meeting confirmed.

2. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – action taken thereon.

Action has been taken on the minutes of the last meetings dated 17.06.2016, 01.07.2016, 12.07.2016 & 26.07.2016. Minutes of the remaining meetings dated 24.05.2016, 03.06.2016, 09.08.2016, 30.08.2016, 07.09.2016, 16.09.2016 and 22.09.2016 still not received from the Central Government/ Oversight Committee.

3. Increase of seats in MS (Ophthalmology) course at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad, Maharashtra under Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University (Deemed), Karad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (09th September 2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad, Maharashtra under Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University (Deemed), Karad for Increase of seats in MS (Ophthalmology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (09th September 2016) and noted the following:-

1. There is a decline in IPD from 4476 in 2014 to 4182 in 2015.
2. There is a decline in major operation from 3847 in 2014 to 3792 in 2015 and in minor operation from 1467 in 2014 to 1320 in 2015.
3. Equipment like Non-contact Tonometer is not available.
4. Nil new books have been purchased for Departmental Library during last 3 years.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad, Maharashtra under Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University (Deemed), Karad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

4. Starting of MD (Pathology) and Diploma in Clinical Pathology (DCP) course at Bidar Institute of Medical Sciences, Bidar under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (08/09/2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Bidar Institute of Medical Sciences, Bidar under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of MD(Pathology) and Diploma in Clinical Pathology (DCP) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (08/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Asst. Prof.: 1; (b) Tutor: 1. (P. 2) (For 100 intake)
2. No faculty table has been filled without which faculty and their eligibility cannot be decided.
3. Data of Tissues/Organs removed after Surgery are not provided.
4. Workload of CT guided FNAC & USG guided FNAC is NIL.
5. Procedures like Bone Marrow Biopsy, Coagulation workup, Histochemistry are not available.
6. Biopsy samples are inadequate.
7. Equipment like Blood Gas Analyzer, PT & APT Analyzers, Cytospin, HPLC are not available.
8. Workload of investigations like PT, APTT, TT, Reticulocyte Count, Leukemia investigations, Nutritional Anaemia investigations, CSF examination is NIL.
9. Procedures like Bone Marrow Biopsy, Coagulation workup, Histochemistry are not available.
10. Pathological post-mortems are not performed.

11. On the assessment day, there was no histopathological specimen received, no biopsy, only one report was issued.
12. Tissue samples were disproportionate to surgeries.
13. Research lab not equipped.
14. Nil new books have been purchased for Departmental Library during last 3 years.
15. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

Dr. Naveenkumar G Havale was absent and Dr. Sandhaya, LMO had not signed the faculty table, which means she was absent resultantly, deficiency of Assoc. Prof.-1, Asst.Prof.-1 and Epidemiologist -1.
2. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Epidemiologist: 1; (b) M.O. cum Lecturer at RHTC/UHC: 2.
3. Ownership & Control of RHTC & UHC is partial.
4. RHTC: Hostel is under repairs. Mess is not available.
5. UHC is under renovation. Services are temporarily suspended.
6. Equipment required for PG studies are not available as detailed in the report.
7. NIL new books have been purchased for Departmental library during last 3 years.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

3. Paramedical & Non-teaching staff is deficient as detailed in the report.
4. The column of stipend paid by institute to Residents is left blank
5. Equipment & Specialized services are inadequate. Tb culture is not yet started. 2 BOD machines in Mycology laboratory are out of order. Several equipment are nonfunctional as detailed in the report.
6. Molecular Microbiology is not available.
7. Central Research Laboratory is not properly equipped.
8. Nil new books have been purchased for Departmental library during last 3 years.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MD(Microbiology) course at Bidar Institute of Medical Sciences, Bidar under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

7. Increase of seats in MD (Radio-Diagnosis) course at Gajra Raja Medical College, Gwalior under MP Medical Science University, Jabalpur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (11/08/2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Gajra Raja Medical College, Gwalior under MP Medical Science University, Jabalpur for Increase of seats in MD (Radio-Diagnosis) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (11/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Dr. Pankaj Yadav, Assoc.Prof. was absent.
2. MRI & Mammography were outsourced but it is not clear whether it is installed in the campus or outside the campus. SAF has been altered.
3. Details of PG students appeared yearly has not been given.
4. Only 3 static X-ray machines are available against requirement of 6.
5. DSA is not available, it is C-arm which cannot be considered DSA
6. Data of Radiological investigations on day of assessment are not provided.
7. Departmental Library has only 48 books.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD (Radio-Diagnosis) course at Gajra Raja Medical College, Gwalior under MP Medical Science University, Jabalpur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

8. Starting of MD (Physiology) course at Government Medical College, Ananthapuram under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Prof. on 27/12/2014; however both the publications cited in the list of publications in the faculty table are dated 2015 which implies that there were NIL publications on date of promotion against requirement of 2; hence her promotion is not as per Regulations & she cannot be considered.
2. The column of stipend paid by institute to Residents is left blank;
3. Equipment like Digital Physiograph & Med Spirer are not available.
4. Facilities for Neurological tests, Nerve Conduction studies, EMG are not available.
5. Additional technology to minimize animal experimentation is not available.
6. Only 6 new books have been purchased for Departmental Library during last 3 years.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MD (Physiology) course at Government Medical College, Ananthapuram under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

4. Workload of CT guided FNAC is NIL & that of USG guided FNAC is 13 during 2015.
5. There were only 2 Biopsies on day of assessment. Data of tissues/organs removed after surgery on day of assessment are not provided.
6. Workload of investigations like Bone Marrow Biopsy, PT, APTT, TT, Coagulation disorders, Leukemia, Nutritional/Haemolytic Anaemia is NIL.
7. Equipment like Frozen Section, PT & APT Analyzers, Cytospin, HPLC, Histochemistry are not available.
8. Non-teaching staff is inadequate as detailed in the report.
9. Pathological post-mortems are not performed.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MD(Pathology) course at Government Medical College, Ananthapuram under Dr. NTR

2. In respect of Dr. Dilip Hari Mandake, Professor, designation wise experience is not provided in the faculty table; hence it is not possible to verify whether his promotion is as per Regulations or not.
3. Both the sub column of stipend paid by State Govt. to Residents & stipend paid by Institute to Residents have been left blank which is incorrect.
4. Workload of investigations like Bone Marrow Biopsy, PT, APTT, TT, Coagulation disorders workup is NIL. Routine Semen & CSF examination are only occasionally done.
5. Data of Fluid Cytology, Exfoliative Cytology, CT guided & FNAC guided FNAC are not provided. Separate data for organ removal are not available. Analysis of data of nature of diseases is also not available.
6. Equipment like Cytospin, HPLC, PT & APTT Analyzers are not available in the department.
7. Pathological post-mortems are not performed.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

2. Promotion of Dr. Dhananjay Sharma, Assoc. Prof. be verified with regard to eligibility of publications. Dr. Dhananjan Sharma, has appeared in assessment at 3 places.
3. The following faculty have appeared during assessment at other institutes as under:

4. Both RHTC & UHC was taken on lease for a period of only 10 years against the requirement of 30 years. Hence, it is not acceptable.
5. There are no mess facilities in RHTC.
6. RHTC: Deliveries are not conducted. Cold chain facility is not available. Paramedical staff like Medical Social worker is deficient.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In the faculty table he is shown as Senior resident straightaway without any experience as Resident.
2. OPD attendance on day of assessment is only 40.
3. Bed Occupancy is 70.33 % on day of assessment.
4. The building housing Psychiatry ward is in very bad shape, cramped & not properly maintained. Walls are layered with moulds giving unhygienic and unhealthy setting. Water tanks are overflowing which is a potential hazard to patients.
5. OPD needs more space & maintenance.
6. Community Psychiatry (Helpline) is not available.
7. The department does not participate in National Mental Health Programme.
8. Only 3 new books have been purchased for Departmental Library during last 3 years.
9. CPC is not held.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

Prof. - i.e. total 12 faculty & 4 Senior Residents are shown. As per table in Summary at item § 5 on P. 4, there is deficiency of faculty: (a) Asst. Prof.: 2 & also of Senior Residents: 2.
2. Dr. Vegeesh Kumar S R, Prof. & HoD, Lecturer from 01.06.2006 to 30.06.2005, this is not feasible.
3. Faculty table is not signed by any of the faculty. There is no attendance sheet signed by the faculty.
4. Unitwise distribution of faculty & Residents is not provided. Signature of faculty & Resident is not available in the faculty table.
5. Only 2 beds each were occupied in ICCU & MICU on day of assessment.
Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

This discrepancy needs to be clarified. Further, date of commencement of experience as Professor being after cut-off date, there should be 4 publications to his credit; however the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank implying Nil publications.
3. As per table at sr.no.4 of pg3, there are total 8 faculty against the requirement of 12 for 4 unit. As per faculty table there are 10 faculty, the faculty table is

not signed by any faculty members and there is no signed attendance sheet attached.

4. There is Nil Junior Resident.
 5. OPD attendance on day of assessment is only 62. Average of randomly selected days is 76 which is inadequate.
 6. Bed Occupancy was 20 % on day of assessment.
 7. There was NIL Major Operation on day of assessment.
 8. No Specialty clinic is run.
 9. Taking average OPD of 76/day, total OPD in the year would come 27,000 – 28,000/year while MRD data shows annual OPD at 45,000. There is data mismatch.
 10. MRI workload for the whole hospital is only 03 & CT Scan workload for the whole hospital is only 06 on day of assessment. (P. 4)
 11. There are 4 O.T.s with 6 O.T. tables which implies that there are some O.T.s with more than 1 O.T. table which is not as per norms.
- Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

6. There is only 1 Major Operation on day of assessment.
7. Joint Replacement services are not provided.
8. Equipment like Knee Arthroplasty set is not available.
9. Investigative facilities like Nerve Conduction, EMG are not available.
10. MRI workload on day of assessment is only 05.

Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In the column of "Benefit of publications", it is stated "No" implying NIL publications against requirement of 4. Hence her promotions are not as per Regulations & she cannot be considered.
4. Dr. Vijayalakshamma has been promoted as Professor after cut-off date; however in the column of "Benefit of publications", it is stated "No" implying NIL publication against requirement of 4; hence her promotion is not as per Regulations & she cannot be considered.
5. Dr. Anju Aparna, Asst. Prof. possesses DNB qualification. However the name of hospital from where she has done DNB is not specified. Hence it is not possible to verify whether she meets eligibility criteria or not. This needs to be clarified.
6. The following had not signed the faculty table which means they were absent of the day of assessment.

This implies that there is no commitment on part of institute to pay stipend to Residents @ rates prescribed by State Government which is contrary to PG Medical Education Regulations. (P. 8)
8. ART services are not available.
9. MRI workload for the hospital is only 03 on day of assessment.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

5. Dr. Ashwani G.S. Asst. Prof. is DNB. It is not given whether he passed teaching or non-teaching hospital without this, his teahing eligibility cannot be decided.
6. There were only 03 Major Operations on day of assessment.
7. MRI workload for the hospital is only 03 on day of assessment.
8. ICU is shared with General Medicine department; hence it is not clear whether any independent ICU is available with Anaesthesiology department.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

4. Details of beds occupied in MICU, SICU, NICU on day of assessment are not provided.
5. Total number of books in the Departmental library is shown at 80; however number of new books purchased in last 3 years is shown at 128 which is not feasible. The discrepancy needs to be clarified.
6. There are no separate independent bed for emergency medicine, casualty bed cannot be counted, which is not permissible.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (16th September 2016) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course at at Teerthanker Mahaveer Medical College, Moradabad, Moradabad,Uttar Pradesh under Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad, Uttar Pradesh u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2017-2018 from 4(Four) to 9(Nine) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

99. Increase of seats in MD (Pathology) course at Teerthanker Mahaveer Medical College, Moradabad, Moradabad,Uttar Pradesh under Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (16th September 2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Teerthanker Mahaveer Medical College, Moradabad, Moradabad,Uttar Pradesh under Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad for Increase of seats in MD (Pathology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (16th September 2016) and noted the following:-

1. Workload of CT guided FNAC is only 48 & of US guided FNAC is only 100 in 2015.
2. Workload of TT investigations is NIL.
3. Workload of Bone Marrow Biopsy is only 10 in 2015.
4. Pathological post-mortems are not performed.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD (Pathology) course at Teerthanker Mahaveer Medical College, Moradabad, Moradabad,Uttar Pradesh under Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

100. Allow the Private Institutes owning a hospital and fulfilling the bed requirements to start PG courses without UG courses.

Read: the letter dated 28/06/2016 received from Sh. Ali R. Rizvi, Joint Secretary, Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi with regard to allowing the Private Institutes owning a hospital and fulfilling the bed requirement to start PG courses without UG Courses.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the letter dated 28/06/2016 received from Sh. Ali R. Rizvi, Joint Secretary, Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi with regard to allowing the Private Institutes owning a hospital and fulfilling the bed requirement to start PG courses without UG Courses and decided to defer the consideration of the matter and directed that the item be included in the meeting scheduled to be held with the Secretary, Health & F.W., Govt. of India on 13th October, 2016 at 12 noon.

101. Re-consideration of notification dated 08/12/2010 with regard to inclusion of PDCC courses in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 – regarding.

Read: the letter dated 24/05/2016 from the Under Secretary to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi with regard to Re-consideration of notification dated 08/12/2010 with regard to inclusion of PDCC courses in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the letter dated 24/05/2016 from the Under Secretary to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi with regard to Re-consideration of notification dated 08/12/2010 with regard to inclusion of PDCC courses in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 and noted the following:-

1. Post Doctoral Certificate Course (PDCC) was never started with the permission of Medical Council of India.
2. There is no benefit of any kind being given to the holders of this certificate in teaching appointment.
3. In the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, there is no diploma course of one year duration.

The Postgraduate Committee at its meeting held on 15.03.2016 and as approved by the General Body at its meeting held on 30.03.2016 already decided as under:-

“The Council approved the following recommendation of the Postgraduate Committee:

“The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the matter regarding Starting of various PDCC Courses at Amrita School of Medicine, Elamkara, Kochi under Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University (Deemed) and Institute of Medical Sciences, BHU, Varanasi, Banaras, Uttar Pradesh u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17 and decided that these PDCC courses were notified in 2010. The Academic Committee of the Council at its meeting held on 4.3.2016 while considering the issue of Post Doctoral Certificate Courses (PDCC) had authorized its Chairman to seek opinion from the Law Officer. According, the queries posed to the Law Officer for his opinion were as under:-

1. As to whether Post Doctoral Certificate Courses including the Notification issued by the Govt. of India are “Scheduled Qualifications”, meaning thereby that they are included in the appropriate schedule appended to the IMC Act, 1956?
2. As to whether the starting of the said Post Doctoral Certificate Course is covered within the ambit and jurisdiction of provisions included at Section 10(A) of the said Act and commensurate Regulations thereunder.

3. *As to whether the said courses would be covered within the ambit and jurisdiction of provision included at Section 11(2) of the said Act.*

The Law Officer has given his opinion and citing various reasons therein he has opined to the said queries as under:-

As to query No.1

"The PDCC cannot be characterized as a New Or Higher Course of Study or Training (including a Postgraduate Course of Study or Training)" u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 read with Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 as the latter does not contemplate starting of a Certificate Course. The question of inclusion of such a course in the first Schedule of the IMC Act would arise only if such a course is permissible in terms of Section 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 and Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000. As the conclusion on an analysis of legislative provision is that it is not a new or higher course of study or training (including a postgraduate course of study or training), hence such a certificate course cannot be subsequently included in the First Schedule in the IMC Act, 1956 that includes the recognized medical qualifications granted by the Universities or Medical Institutions in India. Hence, once the PDCC cannot be brought within the ambit of Section 10A, then the question of its inclusion in the first schedule of the IMC Act does not arise."

As to query No.2

Once the analysis of the legal provisions yields the results that it is impermissible in the existing legislative scheme to have PDCC, then the inevitable conclusion is that the course is not a new or higher course of study or training (including a postgraduate course of study or training), hence it cannot be called as a course in Medicine. Thus, it is not covered within the ambit and jurisdiction of Section 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 and commensurate Regulations thereto.

As to query No.3

Once the analysis of the legal provisions yields the results that it is impermissible in the existing legislative scheme to have PDCC, then the inevitable conclusion is that the course is not a new or higher course of study or training (including a postgraduate course of study or training), then the question of its following within the ambit and jurisdiction of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 does not arise.

In view of the legal opinion, it is evident that the notification issued in respect of PDCC courses is untenable in the context of binding statutory scheme and hence needs to be annulled.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee recommended that in the light of the Legal Opinion, these PDCC courses may be dispensed with."

In view of the above the committee decided to reiterate the earlier decision taken by the committee as well as General Body.

102. Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Amrita School of Medicine, Elamkara, Kochi, Kerala under Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University (Deemed), Coimbatore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (18th August 2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Amrita School of Medicine, Elamkara, Kochi, Kerala under Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University (Deemed), Coimbatore for Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (18th August 2016) and noted the following:-

1. Dr. Shyam Sunder has been shown as “Professor” in the column of “Designation” in the faculty table; however in the column of experience, it is shown as “Associate Professor” from 01/01/2011 till date. This discrepancy needs to be clarified. Further the column of “Benefit of publications” has been left blank implying NIL publications.
2. Dr. Sunil Rajan is promoted as Professor after cut-off date; however the column of “Benefit of publications” is left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
3. Dr. Gokul Das is shown as “Associate Professor” in the column of “Designation” in the faculty table; in the column of “Experience” in the faculty table, his date of promotion as Asso. Prof. is not shown; as his experience as Asst. Prof. is shown from 21/09/2009 to 20/09/2014, presumably he could not have been promoted after 20/09/2014 – i.e. after cut-off date; however the column of “Benefit of publications” is left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 2; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
4. Dr. P.V. Nitu is promoted as Asso. Prof. after cut-off date; however the column of “Benefit of publications” is left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 2; hence her promotion is not as per Regulations & she cannot be considered.
5. The Institution is paying stipend @ Rs. 32,000, Rs. 33,000, Rs. 34,000 per month to 1st, 2nd and 3rd year residents respectively. The stipend paid in Govt. Medical Colleges is @ Rs. 43,000, Rs. 44,000 and Rs. 45,000 per month. The institution has also stated that the stipend in Govt. Medical Colleges is @ Rs. 32,000, Rs. 33,000, Rs. 34,000 per month which amounts to providing misleading information.
6. Total number of Minor Operations has decreased from 5,942 in 2013 to 5,451 in 2015.
7. Total number of Daycare Operations has decreased from 2,260 in 2013 to 2,159 in 2015.
8. Total number of Caesarean Sections in 2015 is not provided.
9. Details of beds occupied in ICU / Postoperative Care area are not provided.
10. CPC & Death Review meetings are not held.
11. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Amrita School of Medicine, Elamkara, Kochi, Kerala under Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University (Deemed), Coimbatore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

103. Increase of seats in MD (Bio-Chemistry) course at Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sheikhpura, Patna, Bihar under Indira Gandhi Instt of Medical Sciences (Deemed University), Patna u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (16th September 2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sheikhpura, Patna, Bihar under Indira Gandhi Instt of Medical Sciences (Deemed University), Patna for Increase of seats in MD (Bio-Chemistry) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (16th September 2016) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in M.D.(Biochemistry) course at Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sheikhpura, Patna, Bihar under Indira

Gandhi Instt of Medical Sciences (Deemed University), Patna u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2017-2018 from 1(One) to 4(Four) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

104. Starting of MS (Ophthalmology) course at Katihar Medical College, Katihar, Bihar under B.N. Mandal University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (16th September 2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Katihar Medical College, Katihar, Bihar under B.N. Mandal University for Starting of MS (Ophthalmology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (16th September 2016) decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue letter of permission for starting of MS (Ophthalmology) course at Katihar Medical College, Katihar, Bihar under B.N. Mandal University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic year 2017-18 restricting the number of admissions to 2(Two) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

105. Increase of seats in MS (ENT) course at King George Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under King Georges Medical University, Lucknow u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (7th September 2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at King George Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under King Georges Medical University, Lucknow for Increase of seats in MS (ENT) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (7th September 2016) and noted the following:-

1. The Institute is showing 2 Units which require total 6 faculty; however only 5 faculty – i.e. 3 Professors & 2 Asso. Prof. – are available; resultantly there is deficiency of faculty: (a) Asst. Prof.: 1.
2. Unit 2 has only 2 faculty; hence it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
3. Dr. Veerendra Verma has been promoted as Professor after cut-off date; however the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
4. Dr. Sunil Kumar & Dr. Hitendra P. Singh have been promoted as Asso. Prof. after cut-off date; however the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 2; hence their promotion is not as per Regulations & they cannot be considered.
5. BERA is not available in this department. Workload of BERA was NIL on day of assessment.
6. Workload of Impedance Audiometry was NIL on day of assessment as well as on randomly selected days.

7. Total workload of Operations like Oesophagoscopy, Foreign Body Removal was only 1 & of Rhinoplasty was only 5 during the preceding 3 year period.
8. Investigative facilities like Nerve Conduction, EMG are not available in this department.
9. Nerve Stimulator / Monitor is not available.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MS (ENT) course at King George Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under King Georges Medical University, Lucknow u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

106. Increase of seats in MD (Paediatrics) course at Meenakshi Medical College and Research Institute, Enathur, Tamilnadu under Meenakshi University (Deemed), Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (29th August 2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Meenakshi Medical College and Research Institute, Enathur, Tamilnadu under Meenakshi University (Deemed), Chennai for Increase of seats in MD (Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (29th August 2016) and noted the following:-

1. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Asso. Prof.: 1.
2. Shortage of Senior Residents: 2. Units II & III do not have any Senior Resident.
3. Unit I does not have Asso. Prof. It has only 2 faculty; hence faculty complement is incomplete & it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
4. Unit III has only 2 faculty; hence faculty complement is incomplete & it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
5. Dr. L. Kalpana has been promoted as Professor after cut-off date; however there are only 2 publications cited in the list of publications shown in the faculty table against requirement of 4; hence her promotion is not as per Regulations & she cannot be considered.
6. Bed Occupancy was only 14.44 % (i.e. 13 out of 90 beds) on day of assessment.
7. OPD attendance was only 72 on day of assessment.
8. Occupancy in PICU / NICU was only 50 % on day of assessment.
9. Services like Endoscopy, Dialysis, HIV are not available.
10. Equipment like Paediatric Endoscope, Paediatric Bronchoscope, PFT, Colour Doppler are not available.
11. MRI workload for the whole hospital is only 07 on day of assessment.
12. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD (Paediatrics) course at Meenakshi Medical College and Research Institute, Enathur, Tamilnadu under Meenakshi University (Deemed), Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

107. Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Muzaffarnagar Medical College, Muzaffarnagar, Uttar Pradesh under Ch. Charan Singh University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (16th September 2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Muzaffarnagar Medical College, Muzaffarnagar,

Uttar Pradesh under Ch. Charan Singh University for Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (16th September 2016) and noted the following:-

1. Dr. Manish K. Tiwari, Senior Resident does not have any experience as Resident in a medical college affiliated hospital before appointment as Senior Resident; hence not qualified to hold the post.
2. Dr. Anurag Singhal, Senior Resident has experience as Resident in a medical college affiliated hospital of only 10 month against requirement of 3 y before appointment as Senior Resident; hence not qualified to hold the post.
3. Dr. Arvind Shurpali, Professor has been shown working at Navodaya Medical College as Asso. Prof. from 16/06/2010 to 08/10/2010 – i.e. only 4 m; however in the column of "Duration" it is shown "2 y" which is a mismatch. This needs to be clarified.
4. Dr. N.K. Maheshwari, Senior Resident has experience as Resident of only 1 y 10 m against requirement of 3 y before appointment as Senior Resident; hence not qualified to hold the post.
5. 3rd year PGs are posted at Metro Hospital, Meerut for training in Cardiac Anaesthesia which is a non-teaching institute which is not permissible.
6. MRI workload on day of assessment is only 06.
7. Details of beds occupied in ICU / Post-operative care area are not provided.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Muzaffarnagar Medical College, Muzaffarnagar, Uttar Pradesh under Ch. Charan Singh University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

108. Starting of MS (General Surgery) course at Kalinga Institute of Medical Sciences, Bhubaneswar under KIIT University, Bhubaneswar u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (30/08/2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Kalinga Institute of Medical Sciences, Bhubaneswar under KIIT University, Bhubaneswar for Starting of MS (General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (16/09/2016) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Vijaynagar Institute of Medical Sciences, Bellary under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of Diploma in Psychiatry (DPM) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (16/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. There is no Asso. Prof. in the only Unit; resultantly faculty complement is incomplete in the only Unit & it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
2. Dr. Khaza Minuddin, Senior Resident does not have any experience as Resident before appointment as Senior Resident; hence not qualified to hold the post.
3. Clinical Psychologist is not available.
4. OPD on day of assessment was only 40. Average of randomly selected days is only 35.
5. Equipment for Psychological Evaluation are not available.
6. In the sub-column of "Stipend paid by Institute to Residents" is "NIL". It needs to be clarified whether stipend to Residents will be paid to Residents or not.
7. Departmental Library has only 54 books.
8. CPC is not held.

9. MRI is not available.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

Subject: **Consideration of Order dated 22.04.2016 of the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay in WP No. 1001 of 2014 and WP No. 1234 of 2014 –Reg.**

Pursuant to the communication from Council office in respect of the aforesaid subject matter, the Dean of LTNM Medical College was requested to appear before the PG Committee on 29.09.16. On behalf of the Dean, Prof. Dr. Rajeev Satoskar, Head, Department of Surgery, LTNM Medical College appeared before the Postgraduate

Committee with records relating to admission in the academic year 2012-13 in the subjects of MS (Ortho) and MD (Pathology). He informed the Committee that the one excess admission in both these subjects for the academic year 2012-13 had taken place due to clerical error. He submitted to the Committee that in the subsequent academic year, i.e., 2013-14 the College had unilaterally made one admission less than the sanctioned intake capacity. He also placed before the Committee a communication from the Dean of the College. However, on perusal by the Committee it was observed that the seat matrix in respect of both these subjects was not clearly stated. The Committee after deliberations decided that the Dean should be asked to submit the details of admission made for the academic years 2012-13; 2013-14; 2014-15; 2015-16 and 2016-17 in both these subjects with sanctioned intake capacity. The copy of communication that has been made to the affiliating University, i.e. Maharashtra University of Health Sciences in respect of both these subjects for these academic years should also be submitted. Prof. Rajiv Satoskar was requested to furnish the aforesaid information by email / fax and speed post expeditiously.

Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
