The Chairman welcomed the members of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee.

1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – confirmation of.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee confirmed the minutes of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 10.10.2017.

2. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – action taken thereon.

Action is being taken on the minutes of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 10.10.2017.

The decision in respect of Item No.68 of the meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Committee held on 10.10.2017 be read correct as under instead of earlier decision:-

“The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor’s Report (13.09.2017) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MD(DVL) qualification against increased intake from 2 to 3 seats granted by D.D.U. Gorakhpur University, Gorakhpur, Uttar in respect of students being trained at BRD Medical College, Gorakhpur be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Committee also decided to recommend to the Central Government that the recognition of MD(DVL) qualification for 2 seats & DDVL qualification for 1 seat granted by D.D.U. Gorakhpur University, Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh in respect of students being trained at BRD Medical College, Gorakhpur be renewed.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.”

Note: In future college will admit only 3 students(seats) (instead of 5)

3. Manipal University, Manipal - Renewal of recognition of MD(DVL) qualification for 01 seat in respect of students being trained at Kasturba Medical College, Mangalore.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (06.09.2017) along with the Council Assessor’s Report (April, 2016 & 27.02.2017) and compliance dated 30.06.2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of recognition MD(DVL) qualification for 01 seat in respect of student being trained at Kasturba Medical College, Mangalore.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (06.09.2017) along with the Council Assessor’s Report (April, 2016 & 27.02.2017) and compliance dated 30.06.2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that the recognition of MD(DVL) qualification for 01 seat granted by Manipal University, Manipal in respect of students being trained at Kasturba Medical College, Mangalore be renewed.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

4. Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, New Delhi - Recognition of MS(Ophthalmology) qualification for 02 seats in respect of students being trained at ESI-PGIMSR,ESI-Hospital, Basaidarapur, New Delhi.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (28.08.2017) along with the Council Assessor’s Report (April, 2016) and compliance dated 07.07.2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(Ophthalmology) qualification for 02 seats in respect of student being trained at ESI-PGIMSR, ESI-Hospital, Basaidarapur, New Delhi.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (28.08.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (April, 2016) and compliance dated 07.07.2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognize MS(Ophthalmology) qualification for 02 seats granted by Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, New Delhi in respect of students being trained at ESI-PGIMSR, ESI-Hospital, Basaidarapur, New Delhi because of the following facts:-

1. Dr. Vandana Kohli is shown as "Asso. Prof." in the column of "Designation"; however in the column of "Experience" it is shown as "Professor" w.e.f. 25/07/2015 till date. No explanation is given for this dichotomy.
2. Facility for Corneal Surgery is not yet available.
3. A few beds in Ophthalmology ward were occupied by Dengue patients; resultantly Bed Occupancy for Ophthalmology is less than 25%.
4. Dr. Anil D Mehta, Prof. was not available on assessment day.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 2(Two) seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

5. MGM Institute of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai - Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 06 seats in respect of students being trained at MGM Mission's Medical College , Navi Mumbai.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (07.09.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2017) and compliance dated 13.07.2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 06 seats in respect of student being trained at MGM Mission's Medical College, Navi Mumbai.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (07.09.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2017) and compliance dated 13.07.2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MS(Orthopaedics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 06 seats granted by MGM Institute of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai in respect of students being trained at MGM Mission's Medical

College, Navi Mumbai be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

6. MGM Institute of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai - Recognition of MD(Psychiatry) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats in respect of students being trained at MGM Mission's Medical College , Navi Mumbai.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (30.08.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2017) and compliance dated 13.07.2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Psychiatry) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats in respect of student being trained at MGM Mission's Medical College, Navi Mumbai.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (30.08.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2017) and compliance dated 13.07.2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MD(Psychiatry) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats granted by MGM Institute of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai in respect of students being trained at MGM Mission's Medical College, Navi Mumbai be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

7. Sumandeeep Vidyapeeth, Vadodara - Renewal of recognition of DCH qualification for 02 seats in respect of students being trained at Smt. B.K. Shah Medical Institute & Research Centre, Vadodara.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (11.09.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (April, 2017) and compliance dated 28.06.2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of recognition DCH qualification for 02 seats in respect of student being trained at Smt. B.K. Shah Medical Institute & Research Centre, Vadodara.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (11.09.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (April, 2017) and compliance dated 28.06.2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that the recognition of DCH qualification for 02 seats granted by Sumandeeep Vidyapeeth, Vadodara in respect of students being trained at Smt. B.K. Shah Medical Institute & Research Centre, Vadodara be renewed.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition.

Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

8. Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad - Recognition of MD(Community Medicine) qualification for 2 seats in respect of students being trained at Hind Institute of Medical Sciences , Barabanki

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (28.08.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2016) and compliance dated 24.04.2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Community Medicine) qualification for 2 seats in respect of student being trained at Hind Institute of Medical Sciences , Barabanki.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (28.08.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2016) and compliance dated 24.04.2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Community Medicine) qualification for 2 seats granted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad in respect of students being trained at Hind Institute of Medical Sciences , Barabanki because of the following facts:-

- (1) At RHTC, none of Paramedical workers had their I.D. proof or were able to explain their job responsibilities.
- (2) Dr. V.S. Nigam, Asst. Prof. purportedly posted at RHTC could not tell name of a single worker posted at RHTC. It means he is not a regular faculty.
- (3) There is no proof of implementing any National Programme at RHTC.
- (4) With regard to Dr. Deepti Singh, Asst. Prof. posted at UHC, there is discrepancy between salary shown as paid and shown in Form 16.
- (5) There was no attendance register of any paramedical worker at UHC.
- (6) Hospital statistics appear to be highly inflated.
- (7) Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 2(Two) after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

9. **Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik - Recognition of MD(Radiodignosis) qualification against increased intake from 1 to 2 seats in respect of students being trained at Bombay Hospital Institute of Medical Sciences, Mumbai.**

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (29.08.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (August, 2016 & 23.03.2017) and compliance dated 16.06.2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Radiodignosis) qualification against increased intake from 1 to 2 seats in respect of student being trained at Bombay Hospital Institute of Medical Sciences, Mumbai Bombay Hospital.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (29.08.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (August, 2016 & 23.03.2017) and compliance dated 16.06.2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Radiodignosis) qualification against increased intake from 1 to 2 seats granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Bombay Hospital Institute of Medical Sciences, Mumbai Bombay Hospital because of the following facts:-

1. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Asst. Prof.: 2.
2. Dr. Somesh Lala is shown as "Asst. Prof." in the faculty table & as "Senior Resident" in the attendance sheet. No explanation is given for this dichotomy.
3. In the attendance sheet, in respect of Dr. Sonali Shah, in the column of "Designation", the words "Asst. Prof." are struck off by hand & substituted by the words "Senior Registrar". Further, her name is not shown in the faculty table at all. No explanation is provided for this dichotomy.
4. Workload of ultrasound guided FNAC and CT guided FNAC had decreased.
5. On assessment day there were only 9 MRI, 30 ultrasounds in the entire hospital, which is not adequate.
6. Faculty table is not attached with the report.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 1 to 2 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

10. **Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh - Recognition of MD(General Medicine) qualification for 03 seats in respect of students being trained at Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Kadapa.**

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (05.09.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (June, 2016, 20.03.2017 and 20.03.2017) and compliance dated 15.06.2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(General Medicine) qualification for 03 seats in respect of student being trained at Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Kadapa.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (05.09.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (June, 2016, 20.03.2017 and 20.03.2017) and compliance dated 15.06.2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(General Medicine) qualification for 03 seats granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh in respect of students being trained at Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Kadapa because of the following facts:-

1. Dr. K.B. Yadavendra Reddy, Professor & Head, was not available on the day of assessment.
2. Dr. Sashi Bhushan Reddy, Asst.Prof. was not available on the day of assessment.
3. Dr. S. Chandra Babu, Professor, was not available on the day of assessment.
4. Promotion of Dr. Vijay Narasimha Reddy, Assoc.Prof., is not as per regulations. He was promoted on 05.12.2014 after the cut off date without two required research publications.
5. Investigative facilities like Nerve Conduction, EMG are not available.
6. MRI is not available.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 3(Three) after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

11. **Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik - Renewal of recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification for 1(One) seat & recognition against increased intake from 01 (One) to 02 (Two) seats (M.S. Orthopaedics) and recognition of D.Ortho qualification for 02 seats in respect of student being trained at A.C.P.M.Medical College, Dhule.**

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (11.09.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report ((May, 2014) , (January, 2015) ,(June, 2015), 05.04.2016, 21.11.2016 and 07.04.2017) and compliance dated 23.06.2017 and 03.07.2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of recognition MS(Orthopaedics) qualification for 1(One) seat & recognition against increased intake from 01 (One) to 02 (Two) seats (M.S. Orthopaedics) and recognition of D.Ortho qualification for 02 seats in respect of student being trained at A.C.P.M.Medical College, Dhule.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (11.09.2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report ((May, 2014) , (January, 2015) ,(June, 2015), 05.04.2016, 21.11.2016 and 07.04.2017) and compliance dated 23.06.2017 and 03.07.2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to renew the recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification for 1(One) seat and not to recognize MS (Orthopaedics) qualification against increased intake from 01 (One) to 02 (Two) seats and D.Ortho qualification for 02 seats granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at A.C.P.M.Medical College, Dhule because of the following facts:-

1. There are only 2 faculty in Unit II; hence it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
2. There is no Senior Resident in Unit II.
3. Average OPD attendance is 30-60/day. On the day of assessment total OPD was 30-40. Bed occupancy 30% and major operation – nil & minor operation -1. The clinical material is grossly inadequate.
4. There are only 2 Examination rooms in OPD.
5. MRI is not functional.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 1(One) till renewal of their recognition will be irregular/illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of recognition granted u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"...the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course."

Admissions done (if any) against these increased number of seats i.e. increased intake from 01 (One) to 02 (Two) seats and D.Ortho qualification for 02 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

2. Units 5, 6, 7, 8 have only 1 faculty each; hence they cannot be considered as a teaching Units.
3. Dr. Deepak Ghuliani is promoted as Professor after cut-off date; however in the column "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table, it is stated 'NIL' against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
4. Services like Upper GI Endoscope, Colonoscope are not yet provided by the department.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 07 to 16 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. 1. Faculty deficiency Assoc.Prof. -1, Sr. Resident -1.
2. Only 3 Senior Residents are present against requirement of 4; resultantly there is shortage of Senior Resident: 1.
3. Dr. K.K. Venkatesh, Sr. Resident, has DA qualification. He has no 3 years experience as Jr. Resident in a teaching institute, when appointed as Sr. Resident. Hence, not eligible.
4. 3 Sr. Residents were absent on the day of assessment.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 04 to 05 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. 1. Dr. Pradeep G Nayar, presently Professor & Head was shown Asst.Professor in earlier report from 2007-2009 (including in faculty table, his Declaration Form and Appointment order dated 14.12.2007. However, in the present compliance this period has been changed to Associate Professor (a new appointment order bearing the same number and date (14.12.2007) has been changed from Asst. Prof. to Assoc.Prof. Such retrospective changes to make the faculty eligible are not allowed and amounts to supplying misleading information.
2. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

3. Dr. Vilas More, Asst.Prof. is neither MD in IHBT nor has 2 years special training. Hence, not eligible.
4. Dr. Dafle Virednra D, Asst.Prof. is neither MD in IHBT nor has 2 years special training. Hence, not eligible.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

1. None of the Sr. Resident is eligible. They have no 3 years experience from a teaching hospital as Jr. Resident when appointed as Sr. Resident. Hence, not eligible. Resultantly, shortage of Senior Residents: 4.
2. No reply has been given for other deficiencies pointed out 1st time in the assessment report. Only reply to DSA has been given.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 2(Two) after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. 1. Dr. Aiswarya Sankar, Senior Resident in Unit II, has only 2 y experience as Resident in a teaching hospital; hence not qualified to hold the post. There is no other eligible Senior Resident in the Unit.

2. Dr. Jemila James, Asst.Prof.– passed DNB from non-teaching hospital. She has no 3 years experience from a teaching hospital as Jr. Resident prior to her appointment. Hence, not eligible.
3. Rekha S Nair, Asst.Prof.– passed DNB from non-teaching hospital. She has no 3 years experience from a teaching hospital as Jr. Resident prior to her appointment. Hence, not eligible.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 2(Two) after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. 2. Dr. S.N. Gole, Assoc.Prof., Unit-V, has not signed the Attendance Sheet and there is no Declaration Form, which means he was absent. However, he has signed the faculty table, which is not feasible. Resultantly, there is no Assoc.Prof. in Unit-V, and it cannot be considered a teaching unit.
3. There is NIL Senior Resident; resultantly there is shortage of Senior Residents: 5.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 07 to 09 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 01 to 03 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. 13. Faculty table gives no experience details of the faculty members in different rank without which their eligibility cannot be decided.

Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik along with the recommendations dated 29/09/2017 of the Oversight Committee.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (12/07/2017) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD (Respiratory Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 1 to 2 seats at N.K.P. Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik along with the recommendations dated 29/09/2017 of the Oversight Committee and observed that :

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (29/06/2017) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD (Forensic Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 2 to 3 seats at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan granted by West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata along with the recommendations dated 29/09/2017 of the Oversight Committee and observed that :

Hence, it was decided by PG committee to grant recognition overruling assessor.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (16/06/2017) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD (General Medicine) qualification for 5 seats at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital,Udaipur granted by Geetanjali University, Udaipur along with the recommendations dated 29/09/2017 of the Oversight Committee and observed that :

- (i) On Reconsideration of the report, it was observed that neither the assessor has made any adverse observations nor there is any deficiency of faculty. The college has 150 UG seats. It has 5 PG units with 40 beds and 3 faculty + SR+JR (as required) in each unit.

84. Bharath University, Chennai - Renewal of Recognition of MD(Pharmacology) qualification for 3 seats in respect of students being trained at Sree Balaji Medical College & Hospital, Chennai.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (08/06/2017) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of Recognition of MD (Pharmacology) qualification for 3 seats at Sree Balaji Medical College & Hospital, Chennai granted by Bharath University, Chennai along with the recommendations dated 29/09/2017 of the Oversight Committee.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (08/06/2017) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of Recognition of MD (Pharmacology) qualification for 3 seats at Sree Balaji Medical College & Hospital, Chennai granted by Bharath University, Chennai along with the recommendations dated 29/09/2017 of the Oversight Committee and observed that :

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There are already 60% seats lying vacant in Pre and Para Clinical departments in the country and there is Acute Shortage of faculty in these departments. In view of above and availability of adequate faculty in the college, it was not considered justified to hold recognition of the Degree.

85. NIMS University, Jaipur - Recognition of M.Ch (Urology) qualification for 1 seat in respect of students being trained at National Institute of Medical Science & Research, Jaipur.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (06.10.2017) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of M.Ch (Urology) qualification for 1 seat at National Institute of Medical Science & Research, Jaipur granted by NIMS University, Jaipur.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (06.10.2017) and decided to recommend not to recognize M.Ch. (Urology) qualification for 1 seat granted by NIMS University, Jaipur in respect of students being trained at National Institute of Medical Science & Research, Jaipur because of the following facts:-

1. Dr. Nisar Ahmed is promoted as Assoc. Prof. after cut-off date; however in the column "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table, it is stated "No" implying Nil publication against requirement of 2; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
2. Dr. Lokesh Sharma is promoted as Assoc. Prof. after cut-off date; however the column "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table is left blank implying NIL publication against requirement of 2; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
3. Workload of Operations like Lithotripsy, Reconstructive Surgery, USG guided Biopsy, OIU, Pyelolithotomy, Ureterolithotomy, Cystectomy, Emergency Surgery was NIL on day of assessment as well as on randomly selected days. There was only one TURP and one URSL on the day of assessment. No other procedure done on the day of assessment.
4. Workload of Lithotripsy, Reconstructive Surgeries, USG guided Biopsies, Emergency Trauma Surgeries was NIL during the period of proceeding 3 years.
5. Workload of Open Surgeries was very low in 2016 as detailed in the report.
6. Equipment like ESWL is not functional.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 1(one) after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

However only 3 publications are cited in the list of publications in the faculty table against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered. All 3 publications are review articles in State Medical Journal.
2. Chronic Psychiatry care service is not provided.
3. Details of participation in National Mental Health Programme are not provided.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 1(One) after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. 2. Promotion of Dr. Anurag Gupta, Professor, is not as per regulations. He was promoted on 22.05.2016 after the cut off date. He doesn't have required 4 research publications.

1. Promotion of Dr. (Col.) R.K. Tripathi, Prof., is not as per regulations. His experience at Base Hospital MH, Jodhpur, cannot be counted because this hospital is not in the list of teaching hospitals of Army. Resultantly, he was Asst. Prof. for only 2 years and Assoc prof. for 3 years and he has no publications at the time of promotion.
2. Faculty deficiency: Assoc.Prof.-2 & Asst.Prof. -1.
3. Dr. Pravin K. Das is promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 3 y as Asst. Prof. His experience as Senior Resident cannot be considered towards promotion for Asso. Prof. as it is not as per Regulations. Further no details of research publications are given.. Deficiency remains as such.
4. Dr. Mamta Harjai is promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 3 y as Asst. Prof. Her experience as Senior Resident cannot be considered towards her promotion for Asso. Prof. as it is not as per Regulations. Further no details of her research publications are given. Deficiency remains as such.
5. Dr. Shivani Rastogi is promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 3 y as Asst. Prof. Her experience as Senior Resident cannot be considered towards her promotion for Asso. Prof. as it is not as per Regulations. Further no details of her research publications are given. Deficiency remains as such.
4. Explanation provided for Bed Occupancy being 66.5 %that it is due to half of the faculty were on vacation is neither tenable nor acceptable .Patients do not come to hospital depending upon the vacation of the faculty.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Hence, MCI cannot recognize those students who were awarded degree /passed out in November, 1990. There is no relevance that the same course is running in different medical college under the same university. However, in the interest of students legal opinion from ASG be obtained.
